Welcome to Hartville! You may like to know a little about this Village and the following information may be of value to you.

The Village government is divided into three functions; Legislative, Administrative and Judicial.

The legislative body is composed of Council which includes Mrs. Kelly Ries, Mr. Jim Sullivan, Mr. David Hubbell, Mr. Jon Caiazza and Mrs. Bev Green. They are all interested in all phases of legislative work and they have been particularly active in their Council committees, namely Commerce Development, Finance, Personnel/Handbook, Planning, Recreation & Parks, Safety, Sewer Rates, Street & Drainage and Zoning. The members of the various committees can be found at the Village Office. I know you will find them all friendly and cooperative.

The administrative functions are divided into:

1. The Fiscal Officer is Mr. Scott Varney.
2. Street repair and maintenance, being administered under Mr. Nate Miller, Street Superintendent.
3. The safety is administered by Chief Larry Dordea together with his police officers. I think you will find the entire police force friendly and cooperative. In case of an emergency please call 911. Non-emergency issues you may call 330-877-2500 and the Stark County Sheriff's dispatch will assist you.
4. The fire protection is handled by the Hartville Fire Department under Chief Richard Kamerer. In case of an emergency please call 911. Non-emergency issues you may call 330-877-2478.

The judicial function is handled by the mayor in cases of misdemeanors and traffic violations. Other infractions are sent to Canton Municipal Court for handling.
